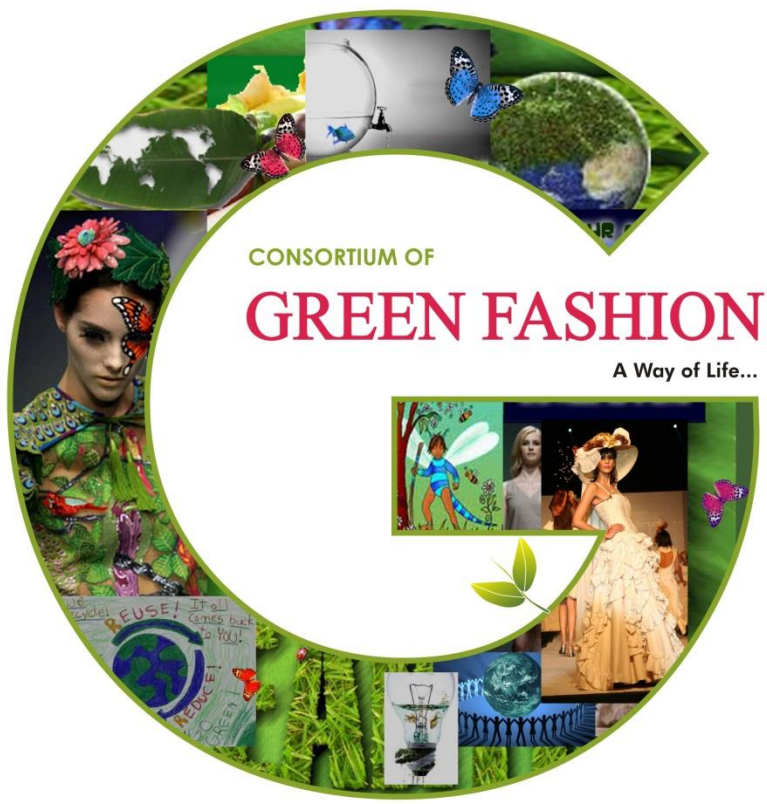

Pre-requisites: Material to be brought by participants

1. White plain collarless cotton medium-sized T-shirts
2. Paints
3. Cotton
4. Sponge
5. Rope
6. Thread
7. Tissues and newspapers
8. Bottles and caps
9. Waste cloth
10. Bowl and water
11. Used toothbrush
12. Pencil
13. Eraser
14. Marker
15. Rag
16. Palette
17. Label to affix of T shirt
18. Cardboard to keep in between the back and front of T shirt

Rules and regulations:

- Time: 1¹/₂ hour includes painting and drying of T shirt
- The T-shirt should be wearable and neat.
- The team that exceeds the time limit will be disqualified.
- No tracing of designs permitted
